BRONZE AWARD



Almost everyone in the school community understands the objectives and is aware of the vision of the Language Charter. The school has built a strong foundation and mechanism for implementing the Charter which includes stakeholders across the school community. The school has drawn up a suitable action plan and is beginning to see the impact of the action in the objectives.

SILVER AWARD
